Safety / Parents in the Building



To ensure the safety of the students by limiting hallway traffic and congestion, ALL students being dropped off should enter through the doors in the corner by the gym (someone will be there to greet). Parents walking students in should park in a parking space and give hugs in the hall prior to the student entering the gym to sit with classmates. For students that do not want to sit in the gym, you may wait in the comfort of your car until the first bell rings at 8:26 am and then send them in through the gym doors. Only the corner doors will be unlocked between 8:05-8:36 am — ALL families must enter through that door. The front doors will be locked until 8:36 am. Any adult in the hallway MUST sign in and have a VISITOR or VOLUNTEER pass from the office. Thank you for helping us create a safer environment for your children.

Skyward

Skyward is the Bay City Public Schools on-line student data base and it can be accessed by parents and students through internet or a cell phone application. Attendance, academic grade books / progress reports and messages from your child's classroom teacher(s) can be viewed on Skyward. All you need is an e-mail address to have access to academic and attendance information for your child(ren), receive messages from your child(ren)'s classroom teacher(s), school newsletters or other school community related information.

If you are not already able to access Skyward, or you forgot your password, please contact the school office, confirm or provide an e-mail address and a Skyward account user e-mail will be sent to your e-mail address. Once you log in, you will be prompted to change your password and you can then begin using Skyward. We will have a Parent Information Night for Skyward on September 19th from 4-6 pm.

DISTRICT VOLUNTEER APPLICATION

Anyone interested in volunteering must complete a Bay City Public Schools Volunteer Application on-line. Applications are ONLY on-line this year. Go to bcschools.net, Parent Information, Volunteer application. . If you plan to participate in your child's classroom in any manner, we encourage you to complete the application on-line as soon as possible. Even if you have previously volunteered, **we must have this application completed**. This includes field trips. We must have a volunteer application on file two weeks before attending any field trips.

All volunteers must complete the application on-line. Once this is done, it will need to be in 2 years.

So...how do you submit them digitally? IT IS SUPER EASY!

- ◆ go to BTFE in your smartphone app store to download the app. Follow the prompts to create an account and "find a school" (it is easiest to search for Hampton School by zip code).
- ◆ After purchasing participating products, go to your BTFE app and take a picture of your receipt (you must do this within 14 days of purchase), press "done", and that's it!
- ◆ Parents find it easiest to do right after they check out, takes about 30 seconds!
- ◆ There is a Box Top window located right outside the office with all the info or the BTFE website is also very helpful. You can submit online shopping receipts by simply forwarding the e-mail receipt to:

STUDENT AWARDS

Helpful Hawk - When a student is caught doing something helpful, kind or responsible they will be given a raffle ticket. Students will write their name on their raffle ticket and place it in their grade level bins outside of the office. Each week there will be a live drawing for each grade level over the announcements for one Helpful Hawk award per grade level. Students will have the opportunity to choose their reward from a list of fun activities.

Ultimate Hawk - At Hampton we strive for our students to live by the standards of being *Safe, Only Respectful, Always Kind, and Responsible*. Throughout each month classroom teachers and resource room teachers will be looking for students who are displaying the above standards as well as, outstanding behavior, and academic effort. Teachers will nominate one student a month per class. In an effort to keep the award special, students will only be able to receive the award once a school year.

At the beginning of the month we will hold a SOAR Assembly with the whole school. Students who have been nominated by their teachers will be recognized in front of the whole student body and receive a Ultimate Hawk award. At this assembly an individual picture of the recipients will be taken as well as a group picture for the grade level.

On the back of the award will be an invitation for students to invite their families to a Ultimate Hawk Reception, which will be held a couple weeks after the assembly (so that parents can make arrangements). At the determined date, we will have a reception for the Ultimate Hawks and their families in the cafeteria. Guests will need to sign in at the office and wait until 2:45 when their Ultimate Hawk will be released from class to come greet you outside the cafeteria. At the reception there will be a treat and punch, and we encourage families to bring games, crafts, cards, or whatever your student might enjoy doing with you. At the reception families will receive a framed picture of their Ultimate Hawk with his/her award - the grade level group picture will be displayed in the hallway for the whole year.

We know how difficult it can be to find time to have quality one - on - one time with your children. Our hope is to make this award an extra special experience with your specially nominated student. By doing so, *we ask that any siblings remain in class during the celebration to ensure that this time is special for your Ultimate Hawk (siblings will have an equal opportunity to be nominated for their own award :)). Once the reception is over, feel free to sign out siblings for the remainder of the school day.*

Celebration Board - We love to hear about our students succeeding in and outside of school! Starting this year we will have a celebration board posted for students to jot down their own personal accomplishments. There will be pieces of paper available for students to grab and quickly write out their celebrations to share with the school. Celebrations will be kept up for one month and then be taken down so we can celebrate a new month's accomplishments!
